JOINING CRAIGIEBURN VALLEY SKI CLUB

Craigieburn Valley Ski Club offers you a great place to ski. In common with most clubs there are many opportunities to meet new friends and have a great social time. There is also a grand feeling of 'belonging'. By contributing to the Club in any way possible it is sure to enhance your appreciation of skiing at Craigieburn! When you join Craigieburn you are stating that you would like to participate in the continued growth of the Club. Everything you can add to the Club will make it a more exciting place to be winter and summer.

New members may join at any time of the year and are entitled to discounted lift tickets and accommodation. Work parties are part of joining the Club but are not compulsory. They are your way of contributing to the Club, and in return for your contribution, the Club is able to offer free lift passes and accommodation. Privileged membership applies to those members who have completed two full work party days prior to the season starting, or paying off those workparties using the workparty buyout scheme⁴. Privileged members are entitled to further discounted rates on tows and accommodation, as well as the opportunity to purchase a season pass.

Your subscription pays towards the administration of the Club. You will also receive an electronic copy of the monthly newsletter "The Towline" giving you details of what's on – on and off the field, social news and gossip and what special events are happening. All Towline newsletters / correspondence is by email unless a \$10 surcharge is paid for a hardcopy. Email address must be provided.

Entrance fees are payable in full by all senior members upon joining the club. Juniors and Intermediates must pay the appropriate entrance fee upon attaining senior status. It may take up to 5 weeks to process your application to be considered by the committee and administered. Please enclose with application the appropriate fee as follows:

⁴ The workparty buyout scheme is the ability to pay off workparties for privileged membership in lieu of completing them in person. This is not available in the first season of membership.
